

LICENSED CLINICAL COUNSELING DIRECTOR

JOB DESCRIPTION: KFAM is a non-profit organization specializing in clinical counseling, family violence intervention, community education, and social services to Korean immigrant families. KFAM is seeking a Licensed Therapist (LCSW, LMFT, or Psychologist) to serve as the Clinical Counseling Director to manage KFAM's Counseling Department. Person will report to Executive Director. This is a full-time exempt position.

JOB DUTIES & RESPONSIBLITIES:

- 1. Clinical Oversight and Program Development
 - Provide crisis intervention support
 - Oversee quality of services including accuracy, timeliness, and productivity
 - Develop/improve and maintain internal systems for charting, billing, documentation, confidentiality, quality assurance, and quality management
 - Oversee clinical program to ensure it meets ethical and legal standards and accepted practices of care
 - Assist in developing and coordinating mental health workshops and community outreach events to reduce stigma and promote mental health services in the Korean community
 - Represent KFAM's clinical counseling department with other community organizations, government agencies, and mental health programs
- 2. Counseling Staff Management
 - Oversee Counseling Department of 4 full-time MFT clinical counselors (licensed and registered interns) and 2-3 part-time practicum students
 - Provide individual and group supervision to non-licensed staff and students
 - Coordinate with consulting psychiatric nurse practitioner and child psychiatrist to provide client medication support
- 3. Contracts & Grants Fulfillment
 - Ensure compliance with government-funded program requirements and procedures, including LA County DMH, DCFS, and Probation Office
 - Oversee audits and program reviews
 - Assist in procurement and development of new grants and contracts to expand counseling department
- 4. These are minimal job requirements. Duties and responsibilities may expand and evolve depending upon needs of the agency or department and the individual's skill set.

Minimum Requirements/Qualifications

- License in Psychology, Clinical Social Work or Marriage Family Therapy (Ph.D., Psy.D., LCSW or LMFT)
- A minimum of **5 years** clinical experience, including at least **2 years** providing services for LA County DMH contracts
- Bilingual Korean speaking a strong plus
- Experience with Electronic Health Records System such as Welligent a plus
- Experience in program planning, program development and implementation, and program evaluation a plus
- Cultural Competency and/or experience working with Korean American community a plus
