Southern California Leadership Program & Summer Internship Application Deadline: June 13, 2014

BACKGROUND

The Asian Pacific Islander American Public Affairs Association- Southern California Regional Headquarters (APAPA-SCR) is awarding a number of internships for Asian and Pacific Islander (API) American college students. Current college students are eligible and encouraged to apply for this internship / scholarship opportunity. The purpose of the internship is to help students better understand California state and local government and to develop future leaders in the API community. Each intern must spend a minimum of 50 hours in the assigned office between July 7 – August 8, 2014, working for a local/state legislator, congress member, or constitutional officer in Southern California. All interns are also required to perform 50 community service hours after the internship under APAPA supervision. Upon completion of the internship, each intern will be awarded a \$500 scholarship. All interns who desire to serve the public and develop their leadership skills are encouraged to become an APAPA member. As a member, you can work closely with elected legislators and officials and participate in the planning of APAPA-SCR's annual signature events. You will have opportunities to further develop your organizational and leadership skills.

INTERNSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The summer internship is a six-week program located at the Southern California area with a planned four-day all expenses paid (including round-trip flights) study tour to the State Capitol. Each selected intern is assigned to a governmental official and/or agency through our placement process.

Students must provide for their own travel, housing, and living expenses for the duration of their internship assignment in Southern California. On every Friday during the internship duration, interns are required to attend the mandatory workshop.

Each applicant who is accepted into the program explicitly grants APAPA-SCR and their sponsors the right to use their likeness and application information for the purpose of promoting and publicizing this Internship Program.

Applicant Eligibility

All student applicants must meet the following criteria:

- ❖ The student applicant must be a resident of California;
- ❖ The applicant must be 18 years old or older on or before July 7, 2014;
- ❖ The applicant must be a **U.S. citizen or permanent resident** with proven documents;
- ❖ The applicant must be currently enrolled as a student at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university;
- ❖ The applicant must possess a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0;
- Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application from separate individuals, neither of whom are related to the applicant, and;
- The applicant must demonstrate commitment to the API community in a written personal statement.

Selection of Scholarship Recipients

APAPA-SCR Scholarship Selection Committee will make awards based on the recipient's demonstrated commitment to the API community, abilities, academic achievements, career goals, civic activities, and leadership skills. All applicants will be notified by mail of the status of their application by June 18, 2014, regardless of outcome.
