## Scholarship Application

### **Program Goals**

The Asian Pacific Islander American Public Affairs Community Education Foundation (APAPA CEF) supports and advances the awareness of Asian and Pacific Islander (API) issues through education and outreach. The Foundation will award a number of scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each to selected students who will be attending college during the 2015-2016 academic year. The scholarships given are based on the availability of funds. The scholarship awards will be paid on the student's behalf to the institution of higher learning where the student will be enrolled. Scholarship funds will not be paid directly to the student. **Previous recipients are not eligible**.

APAPA-CEF does not discriminate on the basis of race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, national and ethnic origin, or disability. In support of APAPA's mission and goals, APAPA encourages applications from students who have Asian or Pacific Islanders ancestry.

## **Applicant Eligibility**

All student applicants must meet the following criteria:

- ❖ The student applicant must be a resident of California;
- ❖ The applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
- The applicant must be currently enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university;
- ❖ The applicant must possess a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.75;
- Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application from separate individuals, neither of whom are related to the applicant, and;
- The applicant must demonstrate commitment to the API community in a written personal statement.

### **Selection of Scholarship Recipients**

APAPA CEF's Scholarship Selection Committee will make awards based on the recipient's demonstrated commitment to the API community, abilities, academic achievements, career goals, civic activities, and leadership skills. All applicants will be notified by mail of the status of their application by March 16, 2015 regardless of outcome.
