In October 2015, California launched a one-time amnesty program for unpaid traffic and non-traffic infraction tickets. Since then, consumers have applied in unprecedented numbers in Los Angeles County. In October alone, the court received over 128,000 inquiry calls and processed nearly 18,000 amnesty applications.

Representatives from A New Way of Life Reentry Project and the Legal Aid Foundation of Los Angeles County are hosting a free training and workshop for attorneys, service providers, and consumer advocates on the Traffic Ticket Amnesty program. The training will cover the benefits and requirements of the program and offer materials and resources to help affected individuals in Los Angeles County apply for this much-needed relief. The training will specifically focus on Los Angeles County.
