# Training Opportunity



The Worker Education & Resource Center is offering a Community Health Worker program to prepare you with the skills to become a community worker with the LA County Department of Health Services. This intense 150-hour course will begin in August 2014 and prepare you to work in the Departments' clinics and hospitals. Participants in the program will be expected to promptly attend all sessions,

approximately 30 hours per week. Participants will receive a training stipend during the course based on attendance and performance.

To be considered for this program applicants are required to:

- Submit a completed application by August 1, 2014
- If your application is complete, you will be scheduled for an assessment of English language verbal and written communication, basic math and computer abilities
- Qualified applicants will be interviewed by a selection committee

**Applicants must have:**

- High school diploma or GED
- Valid CA Class C Driver License or the ability to utilize alternate method of transportation to carry out job-related essential functions
- AND
- Six months of full-time experience working with the public or community groups
- OR
- Six months as a LA County Mental Health Peer Advocate

**There may be additional requirements in connection with LA County's employment application and selection process. Participation in this training program does not guarantee a position with the Department of Health Services, but completion of the program will enhance your skills to be successful in a Community Health Worker role.**
