Dear A3PCON community,

The horrific shootings of multiple Asian American women last week in Atlanta were a jarring reminder that the racist anti-Asian ideologies inflamed by the previous administration and discriminatory media rhetoric, are alive and well in our country. This tragedy sits heavy in our hearts and minds and A3PCON is committed to advocating for stronger protections and more resources for our AANHPI communities, in every facet of our society. Our community is valuable, dynamic, deserving of protection and of freedom to pursue full lives in the country that we've built, together.

[Stop AAPI Hate](#), our collaborative initiative with CAA and SFSU AASD, recently released a [National report](#), which analyzed trends across 3,795 incidents reported. Over 68% of reported incidents came from women, nationally. Similarly in our [Georgia report](#) released in 2020, data shows that 75% of incidents reported, came from women. In [Los Angeles](#), the data showed more congruency with that of the national report, with 68% of the reports coming from women. Through these findings, it's clear to us that women are disproportionately being targeted by perpetrators of anti-Asian racism.

Join us this Saturday, March 27th at 11am to show support for our AAPI community members and commemorate the lives of the AAPI women taken. We will be marching in a show of solidarity with our partners at KYCC and larger member organizations, as well as, other local community groups.

We will be meeting at Berendo Street and Olympic Blvd in Koreatown and marching to Normandie and Olympic, for the main program.
