

Position Overview

Under the direction of the Executive Director, the Director of Civic Engagement is responsible for the development, management, and delivery of the organization's voter engagement programs.

The ideal candidate has ability and vision to further develop and enhance CAUSE programs. The position calls for an individual with experience in political canvassing and registering/engaging voters. Project and personnel management skills are a must. CAUSE seeks candidates with a solid understanding of the political landscape in Southern California as well as a strong desire to empower Asian Pacific Americans (APA) to participate in civic and political spaces.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

Programming

Program Development:

- Develop the overall direction and vision of CAUSE's voter outreach, training, and education programs in accordance with the organization's mission and goals
- Consistently engage relevant stakeholders in discussion and strategizing for program development purposes
- Establish short and long-term program goals and objectives
- Develop key strategies to register, turnout, train, and educate voters
- Incorporate past program evaluations, data, and feedback into future program plans
- Create an outreach strategy to consistently engage and sustain voters
- Support with the development of program-related marketing materials
- Cultivate, manage, and maintain key relationships with community partners; programrelated speakers and workshop facilitators; and voter administration entities

Program Management:

- Conduct regular program evaluations and impact analysis
- Routinely modify and improve program strategies, structures, and processes as deemed necessary by results of program analyses
- Set key deadlines to ensure the quality outcomes for all programs
- Oversee the production of program materials and details
- Oversee vendor coordination
- Monitor the documentation of program-related documents and materials for the purposes of future programming
- Adhere to set program budgets
- Ensure program details are communicated to all relevant stakeholders
- Execute all post-program related follow up activities and communications in a timely manner
- Ensure the overall high quality and success of the organization's civic engagement programs
