

POSITION DESCRIPTION: Analyst, Immigration Investments

We also believe that expanding immigrants' access to community resources creates civic, educational and economic opportunities that strengthen the social fabric of our society. The Role

The Analyst, Immigration Investments will report to the Immigration Portfolio Manager. Working within Emerson Collective's immigration investment portfolios, s/he will support EC's immigration investing team by:

- Conducting landscape analysis to identify immigration industry trends, gaps, and opportunities.
- Assisting with investment processes, including research, partner cultivation, due diligence, documentation, post-investment support of partner organization, and compliance tracking.
- Preparing reports, presentations, memos and other documents for internal and external audiences.
- Developing and maintaining systems for organizing data, materials, and information.

- Helping to conceive of and support events, convenings and trainings that enable partners and peers in the field to learn together.
- Conducting individual communications to external stakeholders.
- As needed, help members of the team with external communications to advance immigration program strategy.
- Collaborating with EC's other teams (communications, special events, policy, etc.) to ensure we are leveraging their tools and capabilities in support of our partners.
- Taking on other special projects and administrative tasks as they arise.

Experience

- 1-3 years of work experience, ideally in philanthropy or nonprofit fields.
- Experience conducting non-profit due diligence a plus.
- Data systems and analysis skills a plus.

- You have excellent written and oral communication skills, including the ability to develop materials for internal and external audiences. You can communicate complex information clearly and concisely with everyone in the organization and with external stakeholders.
- You maintain a team-oriented approach and thrive in entrepreneurial, dynamic environments. You're comfortable taking on new tasks or projects with little direction and adjusting course quickly in response to feedback.
- You have high standards for accuracy, quality and integrity.
- You have a strong orientation towards technology-related strategies and solutions to social problems.
