



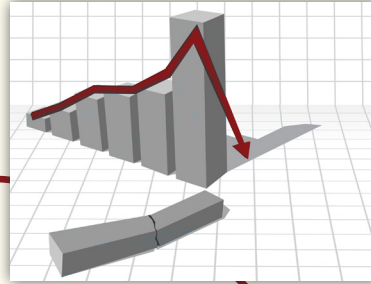
# Civilian Oversight of Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Empowerment Congress

**What does civilian oversight of the Sheriff's Department mean for Los Angeles County?**



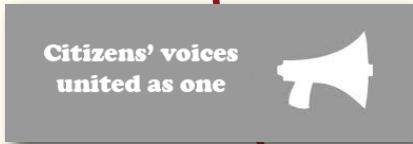
Civilian oversight will give the public a dedicated forum to hold its elected Sheriff and the department accountable.

Public confidence in the Sheriff's Department is at an all-time low. Litigation costs are sky rocketing, in Fiscal Year 2012-2013 alone expenses totaled \$43 million.
