Position: On-call Interpreter (Korean)

DUTIES:

- Translate documents, outreach materials, meeting agendas, and other program documents as needed.

- Provide simultaneous written and oral Korean language translation at meetings and events.
 - Schedule priorities:
 - 2 hours on the First Friday of the Month (all gardeners) 5:30-7:00pm
 - 2 hours on the second Thursday of the Month (Garden Committee) 6:00-7:30pm
 - Potential additional needs:
 - 2.5 hours at the Community day & Gardening Workshop on the Third Saturday on the Month
 - 1.5 hours a month for 1 on 1 meetings with Korean gardeners & special workshops

QUALIFICATIONS:

-Must be fluent in Korean, written and oral.

-Able to also competently communicate in Spanish is a plus but not a requirement.

COMPENSATION

This position is compensated on an on-call basis, it pays \$11 hr.
