Living Arts Long Beach will give you real life-creative-job skills you need to succeed and connect you to professional artists who have careers in the arts. From these guest artists, and the training you will get through written words, graphic design and creative individuals, you will gain insight and exposure on how to take charge of your life in the art field.

There will be 12 Wednesday meetings, all taken place on every other days (unless noted). Guest artists will share and assist you in various skills you need to be ready to put yourself out there in the world of creativity, such as silk screening, T-shirt design, written and spoken words. Guest artists will share their personal journey in their career, advice on ways to grow in their industry, and teach a tangible art skill to get you thinking like a professional artist.

Photography - Resume and Interview and many more!*

Living Arts Long Beach is a 6 month program with 12 meetings of art workshops. At each workshop, a guest artist will present their career path, their specific industry and lead a creative project. Participants will create, design and learn about making and performing art throughout the program. At the end of the program, participants, guest artists will showcase their work at the finale.
