INTERNSHIPS FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS IN L.A. LEGISLATIVE OFFICES

This year's 9-week TACL Political Internship Program (PIP) will take place in Los Angeles from Saturday, June 9, 2018 to Saturday, August 11, 2018. The program includes **full-time placement** in a local district office of a state or federal elected official; **workshops** throughout the summer on leadership, identity, policy, and networking; a **group advocacy project** that culminates in a trip to Sacramento to lobby on an issue important to the TA community; and a one-on-one **mentorship** with an experienced mentor. A stipend of up to \$1,500 may be awarded upon successful completion of the internship.

Since 1992, TACL PIP has sponsored internships in the offices of various elected officials at federal, state, and local levels in order for participants to learn firsthand the inner workings of the political system. Through this program, TACL seeks to empower the brightest members of the Taiwanese American community to make an impact through civic engagement, while developing identity and character through cultural and community awareness.
