Why?

Calling voters allows them to ask questions about the voting process

By being informed voters, the AA & NHPI community will be empowered voters

By providing bilingual and culturally competent voting services, we can increase voter turnout

How?

1. Attend a two-hour training
2. Get a stipend of \$60 after 3rd shift, and \$10 for each shift after
3. A meal is provided per shift
4. Sign up for shift(s) that fit your schedule. Shifts are: M-Th (5:30PM-8:30PM) and Sat (10AM-1PM) during October and November
5. Phone bank out of the Advancing Justice office in downtown Los Angeles, 1145 Wilshire Blvd, Los Angeles 90017
6. Bilingual ability for Bangla, Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Punjabi, Samoan, Tagalog, Thai, Tongan, Urdu, Vietnamese is preferred, but not necessary

Why?

Poll monitoring ensures AA & NHPI voters are gaining access to multilingual resources

Monitoring helps protect the rights of AA & NHPI voters

This project makes sure that AA & NHPI voters are not turned away on election day

How?

1. Attend a two-hour training
2. Be available to volunteer for 2.5 hours on Nov. 4th
3. Be able to drive to two to three polling sites in Los Angeles or Orange County
4. Bilingual ability is a plus, but not necessary
