

Job Title: Case Worker

Basic Function:

Assist in the implementation of direct educational, social, employment, and case management services for high-risk, at-risk, probation, foster care and/or low-income youth and their families in order to help youth overcome barriers to success in their family, school, community, employment and life. Programs include but are not limited to: Employment Services; Educational Pathways & Vocational Opportunities; Home Based Services to High-Risk High-Needs Youth and Families; In-Home Services; Home Based Gender Specific Services; Gang Intervention Services, and Gender Specific Services in the Community.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Facilitate social emotional learning individually or in groups;
- 2. Facilitate youth development activities, mentoring activities and fieldtrips;
- 3. Facilitate parent education programming individually or in groups;
- 4. Facilitate individual assessment and case planning;
- 5. Implement individual service plans;
- 6. Implementation of community education forums, client outreach and recruitment;
- 7. Assist in the implementation of Case Coordination Services;
- 8. Provide support for transportation services for youth;
- 9. Maintain accurate and up-to-date documentation;
- 10. Attend required meetings and trainings;
- 11. Provide services on a flexible schedule including evenings and weekends; and
- 12. Other related duties as assigned by supervisor.

Required Education & Training:

- 1. Bachelors' Degree in Criminal Justice, Social Work, Education, Psychology, Sociology or related field or equivalent experience.
- 2. At least 2 years of related working experience with high-risk, at-risk, probation, foster care, and/or low-income youth and/or parents;
- 3. Experience working with diverse communities;
- 4. Excellent verbal and written communication skills and attention to detail in documentation;
- 5. Computer literate; and
- 6. Must have a valid California driver's license, excellent driving record, and auto insurance.

Preferred Education & Training:

- 1. Bilingual in Mandarin, Cantonese, Vietnamese, or Spanish; and,
- 2. Experience with client outreach and recruitment, group facilitation, home-visitation, and case management.
