Basic Function:

Assist in the implementation of educational pathways and vocational opportunities services appropriate for youth ages 16 to 19 in order to support academic achievement and youth development. Some of the areas we serve include, but are not limited to: Inglewood, Compton, East LA, San Gabriel Valley and Antelope Valley.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide supervision and one-on-one tutoring with youth ages 16 to 19;
- 2. Facilitate homework completion during appropriate times;
- 3. Provide support for GED and college preparation;
- 4. Facilitate academic instruction individually;
- 5. Facilitate individual assessment and planning;
- 6. Maintain accurate and up-to-date documentation;
- 7. Attend meetings and trainings as assigned; and
- 8. Other related duties as assigned by supervisor, or as identified in program manuals or funding source contracts.

- 3. Experience working with diverse communities;
